

Ross Creek Gallery Rental and Exhibition Information

Ross Creek Centre for the Arts welcomes submission proposals from artists and curators. The Centre is a registered not for profit organization dedicated to encouraging and promoting the arts through education and arts development, and provides a professional environment for artists to present work in a non commercial, non-museum venue. All exhibitions, including rentals, are evaluated by our gallery committee.

Shows generally last from 4-6 weeks. Fees are negotiated with artists. Its two main exhibition venues include:

RBC COMMUNITY GALLERY

A small open gallery space with lovely red floors and track lighting, it is a wonderful place for projector presentations, exhibits, meetings and classes.
Size 18' x 25'

Individual artists may rent exhibition space in the RBC Gallery

- \$20/day (2 hours or whole day)
- \$15 a day up to 10 days, after that \$150. 4-5 weeks
- \$40 maintenance fee for painting, crack filling, etc.
- If the gallery processes sales of art, the Ross Creek Gallery receives a 20% commission on sales. HST must be added to all sales managed by Ross Creek.
- All gallery rentals must submit proposals to the Gallery Committee

Ross Creek Gallery -

A secure gallery space with lovely red wood floors and track lighting, it is a beautiful small gallery space which can hold both works on the walls and installation pieces. It has substantial electrical and has internet capacity. The climate can be controlled and the space is lockable.
Size: 18' x 30'

Artists may submit proposals for a public exhibit in this space, with CARFAC fees applied. No outside show will be presented in the gallery without a proposal. Ross Creek's Gallery is an artist run centre. The Gallery's program committee meets twice a year, in October and April. Deadlines for submissions are October 1, and April 1.
